



## How to Prayerwalk

Prayerwalking is praying where we expect God to bring forth His answers. It doesn't require "walking" but does require "praying" in the area of need. Luke 10, where Jesus sent out the 72, offers helpful insights into the approach.

Sometimes referred to as praying "on-site with insight", expect powerful results from prayerwalking. Following is a recommended approach:

- Team up with 2-3 others who share your interest in praying for the issues at hand.
- Define territory for prayer – sets clear ownership.
- Walking not necessary; could be from overlook point over business area.
- Turn to God's Word for direction.
- Close by verifying God's direction for the workplace and defining ongoing prayer plans.
- Best with small groups of people during office downtime.
